


Tauchunfall-Massnahmen-Schema





action plan for diving emergencies



Not a SCUBA diving accident.

- Oxygen 100%
- Horizontal position
- Water (0.5 1 l.) orally
- Observe + 5 Min. Neurocheck

Serious symptoms:

pain, skin troubles, unusual weakness, numbness, tingling, breathing troubles, visual, hearing, speech troubles, vertigo, nausea, paralysis, decreased consciousness, coma.

Remember: any symptom at depth is always serious.

Relief in 30 minutes?



Ireat as serious symptoms.

Consult Physician. Observe 24 hours.

EARLY TREATMENT

- Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), if needed.
- Keep airway open.
- Put diver in horizontal position.
- 4. Give 100% Oxygen with face mask for as long as possible.
- Shelter diver.
- If fully conscious, water (0,5 1 litre) orally.
- Lactate, Normal Saline or 5% dextrose in saline I.V. (No 5% dextrose in water).
- Consult DAN Europe or a diving medicine specialist.
- Plan transportation to hyperbaric chamber.
- If air evacuation: maximum possible cabin pressurization.

If Physician is present: Ringer
